Candidates need to have well-developed competencies in the field of business taxation and business administration with particular emphasis on energy / resource industry.

Teaching obligations include undergraduate and graduate courses in the programs „Business Administration“ (Bachelor, Master), „Engineering Economics“ (Bachelor, Master), „Business Administration for Resource Economics“ (Diploma), „Energy and Resource Economics“ (Master), „Business and Law“ (Bachelor), „International Management of Resources & Environment“ (MBA) and „International Business in Developing and Emerging Markets“ (MBA).

It is expected that candidates are willing to participate actively in research projects with other faculties as well as to collaborate with the „Helmholtz-Institute Freiberg for Resource Technology (HIF)“. The candidate should cooperate in research activities with other scientists of the faculty and related disciplines, in particular the research profile of Technische Universität Bergakademie Freiberg. The faculty is particularly interested in candidates who have an excellent international publication record, the ability to attract external funding, and strong teaching skills.

We expect the ability and willingness to also teach in English, as well as in neighboring subjects areas, if required.

The applicant must meet and fulfil the general prerequisites for an appointment as a professor in accordance with § 58 Sächsisches Hochschulfreiheitsgesetz dated January 15, 2013 (Sächsisches Gesetz- und Verordnungsblatt 2013 sheet No. 1, page 3) in its currently valid and applicable version. The university provides support by furnishing child care and in mediating appropriate job positions for the partner or spouse. The TU Bergakademie Freiberg pursues an instructional and research concept that expects the successful candidate to move his or her main residence to Freiberg or its immediate vicinity.

The TU Bergakademie is committed to increasing the ratio of women in teaching and research positions. That is why qualified female candidates are especially encouraged to apply. Applicants with disabilities will receive preferential consideration, provided they possess equal qualifications, achievements and abilities.
