What is EURECA-PRO?

There are nine partner universities of the **EURECA-PRO** Alliance across eight EU countries who have joined forces to enable students and staff to study, teach and do research in the field of **Responsible Consumption and Production** (RCP). The long-term goal of the alliance is a joined virtual and integrated European campus by 2040.



What are EURECA-PRO Doctoral Studies?

To bring together Doctoral students across all partner universities whilst promoting an understanding of UN Sustainable Development **Goal 12- Responsible Consumption and Production** (RCP), **EURECA-PRO** has launched the **Doctoral Studies Programme**. This allows PhD students researching a topic relating to RCP to have the opportunity to develop their career in research with events, activities and courses from across our partner universities.

Examples of Activities of the EURECA-PRO Doctoral Programme

The annual **EURECA-PRO PhD Journey** is an international mobility programme to network, access research facilities and develop research skills for PhD students. Each Journey is based around a different research theme and hosted at different partner universities. At the annual **Young Researchers Colloquium**, doctoral students can present their research and network.

During the regular online **PhD Seminars**, students present their research to researchers and fellow PhD students from across EURECA-PRO.

Why Join? Benefits and Opportunities

- Develop your international scientific network through opportunities by taking part in EURECA-PRO events including conferences, summer schools and training opportunities.
- Expand your research potential through utilising research facilities at other partner universities within EURECA-PRO.
- Explore possibilities to enrol in joint or double/multiple degrees.
- Upon successful conclusion of your studies, receive a jointly issued certificate of completion from all EURECA-PRO partners reflecting your participation in EURECA-PRO courses and events.

Requirements for Completing the EURECA-PRO Doctoral Training Programme

Requirements

- You are enrolled as a doctoral student at one of the partner institutions of EURECA-PRO.
- Your doctoral research has a link with climate change, sustainability, circularity, or responsible consumption and production.
- You can confidently present your research in English and interact proficiently in English with other researchers.
- You have the approval of your supervisor(s) to join the EURECA-PRO Doctoral School.

Contact your local EURECA-PRO doctoral coordinator to express your interest in joining the EURECA-PRO Doctoral School!

Doctoral students from partner universities of EURECA-PRO can apply to join the 'EURECA-PRO Doctoral School' upon meeting the requirements outlined in the 'Doctoral School on Responsible Consumption and Production' regulations.

Throughout your EURECA-PRO doctoral studies, you must complete activities totalling a minimum of 15 credits as defined and certified by the EURECA-PRO Doctoral School.

- 1 credit corresponds to 10 contact hours
- Credits can be earned through a combination of activities within your own institution and those organised within EURECA-PRO.
- A minimum of 5 credits must be obtained through participation in EURECA-PRO organised activities. Apart from the PhD seminar, no activities are compulsory.
- Credits must be acquired in at least 4 of the 7 clusters as defined in the European Competence Framework for Researchers.
- Previously completed activities during your doctoral studies, but before joining the EURECA-PRO Doctoral School, can also be taken into account.



Note: these requirements do not replace those set by your home/local university. However, if prior agreement is obtained, some requirements from both the home/local university and the EURECA-PRO Doctoral School could be met through the same activities.
