Programme information, accommodation and other

Academic System	two semesters per year = one academic year
Semester Fee	107,-- € (115,-- € from Summer Semester 2026)
Academic Calendar	Winter semester: 1 October to 31 March Summer semester: 1 April to 30 September
Nomination deadline	There is none. Please nominate your students in good time before the application deadline (see above), i.e., at least 14 days ahead. This will allow them to go through our application system.
Application deadline	for the winter semester: 31 May for the summer semester: 30 November
Application process	After receiving the nomination of a candidate, the International Office will inform the nominated student(s) via email about the application procedure.
Required language proficiency	B1 for German B2 for English Language levels above are stated according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, CEFR.
English-instructed courses	tu-freiberg.de/en/international/modules-in-english Courses in English language are available in our English-language Master's programs. Our undergraduate programs are entirely held in German language.
German courses	German language courses (A1 to B2) during the semester are available and free of charge for enrolled students. Upon successful participation, the student earns 4 credit points. The German courses should be included to the Learning Agreement.
Orientation Events	Each semester, one week before the start of the lecture period. Orientation Days are announced on our web page.
Course catalogue	evlvz.hrz.tu-freiberg.de/~vover/index.html?int_fav=en The course catalogue is updated shortly before the start of the semester only. We ask all international students to select the previous semester for reference. The catalogue is available in German only. It will be available in English soon.
Workload per semester	12 ECTS to max. 30 ECTS
Accommodation	A separate online application is required at least three months before the start of the semester at studentenwerk-freiberg.de/freiberg/housing/online-application/en . After completing the form, the applicant will be registered by the dormitory administration. To reserve the place until arrival, the Admission Letter of TUBAF needs to be submitted. The prices for a room range from 240 € to 420 €. A deposit of approximately two months' rent is applicable and will be returned when moving out. Cooking facilities are available. Cutlery, pots and dishes can be bought at the accommodation office. Pillows, blankets and linens may also be bought for a reasonable price. For hygienic reasons, each student must bring their towels. Internet connection is available as standard in all dormitories. The cost is low and included in the rent. The student needs a RJ-45 (LAN/Ethernet) cable or a WLAN router.
