**Job description:**

The focus of our work is on behavioral science research in the field of business and economic ethics. We investigate the influence of personal, situational and organizational factors on ethically relevant actions. We are characterized by a strong research orientation with a clear focus on corporate practice. In doing so, we strive to use complementary, economic and psychological methods to address our research questions. Fields of work include laboratory and field experiments, empirical field studies with company data and microeconomic analyses. We reflect the results of our empirical studies against the background of normative perspectives.

- Work in a dedicated team on joint and own research projects
- the aim of the work is to produce independent studies or studies produced with co-authors, which should be presented at conferences and published in internationally recognized journals
