

### ***Rules for the structured doctoral studies***

Rules from 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2011 and 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2017

Specifications to § 15 of the Regulations for the Award of Doctorates from 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2017

At least 15 credit points have to be gained. Of these, **at least 4 credit points must come from subject-specific courses/lectures/modules**. Up to 6 CP can come from own teaching activities for which a confirmation is necessary. Additional performances in interdisciplinary fields have to be obtained to get 15 credit points in sum.

#### **Subject-specific courses/lectures/modules**

Attendance at subject-specific courses/modules which are selected from a Bachelor / Master programme or a programme for doctoral students from the offer of the TU Bergakademie Freiberg or other Universities/Research institutes. The prerequisite for the recognition of achievements in modules/courses from Bachelor Master or Diploma degrees is that these achievements have not already been gained in the framework of those courses qualifying to undertake the doctorate.

#### **Teaching activities**

For each SWS (hours per week and semester) 0.5 credit points will be taken into account. The applicant needs a confirmation from his/her supervisor about his/her teaching activities. Additionally time for preparation and going over can be taken into account.

#### **Additional interdisciplinary qualifications**

1. Up to 3 CP for presentations can be taken into account. For own presentations at international conferences 1 CP, for presentations on established national conference 0.5 CP can be awarded.
2. Up to 4 CP for publications can be taken into account. For publications in journals which are listed in [www.scopus.com](http://www.scopus.com) lead authors will get 2 CP and co-authors 1 CP.
3. Up to 3 CP can be taken into account for a successful participation in courses offered by GraFA (Centre for Advanced Study and Research).
