Accommodation A separate online application is required at least three months before the start of the semester at

> studentenwerk-freiberg.de/freiberg/housing/online-application/en. After completing the form, the applicant will be registered by the dormitory administration. To reserve the place until arrival, the Admission Letter of TUBAF needs to be submitted. The prices for a room range from 240 € to 420 €. A deposit of approximately two months' rent is applicable and will be returned when moving out. Cooking facilities are available. Cutlery, pots and dishes can be bought at the accommodation office. Pillows, blankets and linens may also be bought for a reasonable price. For hygienic reasons, each student must bring their towels. Internet connection is available as standard in all dormitories. The cost is low and included in the rent. The student needs a RJ-45

(LAN/Ethernet) cable or a WLAN router.
