CHALLENGE

Science and research are often complex and can sometimes be difficult for outsiders to understand. In public discourse, discussions are often based on opinions rather than facts.

OUR PROJECT

With GrünBerg, we want to transform central, unused outdoor areas of the university into green lecture halls and use them to connect the university with society. Student education should become more practice-oriented and relevant to real-world applications, and together, “green” implementation concepts for the energy and resource transition will be developed and discussed. Working on practical issues and interacting with “old hands” enables the “young wild ones” to benefit from their experience (tandem learning). The “green” lecture halls are intended to ease the transition from school to university and from university to the regional economy, and invite debates, discussions, and science slams.
