## Rector's Order on the Attendance at Classroom Teaching Courses and SARS-CoV-2 Testing Offers for Employees

Dear Professors,  
dear Employees and Students at TU Bergakademie Freiberg,

The following regulations on classroom teaching and testing offers for employees shall apply at TU Bergakademie Freiberg from 6 April 2021 until further notice based on § 3 a paragraph 1 and § 5 paragraph 4e of the Saxon Corona Protection Ordinance of 29 March 2021:

1. All employees who are required to be physically present at work are provided with a self-test once a week at no charge.

The self-tests are distributed to the institutes of TU Bergakademie Freiberg via the Dean's offices of the faculties. In the administration and central facilities, the tests can be obtained from the respective supervisors. The tests are to be used according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Employees who hold an approved classroom teaching course are obliged to take a self-test before each classroom teaching course and to supervise the students during the testing.

2. Students who have to attend classroom teaching courses are required to take a supervised self-test immediately before attending the course and to complete the attached statement (certificate). The self-tests are provided by TU Bergakademie Freiberg.

The supervision of the self-tests is carried out by the respective lecturers holding the classroom-based course.

If there are several classroom teaching courses on the same day, it is recommended to take a rapid test at one of the test centres (**test center in the Municipal Festival Hall on the Obermarkt**, DRK [German Red Cross]). The certificate issued by the test centre is valid throughout the day.

In case of a positive test result, please refer to the instructions on the reverse side of the enclosure.

### **Important information in case of a positive test result after a self-test**

- You are obliged to have a PCR test carried out immediately by a doctor or a test centre.
- You must stay at home and isolate yourself until the result is available. Only leave your flat or house in case of medical or other emergencies.
- Your household members (family, shared apartment) shall reduce their contacts. If the PCR test confirms the infection (i.e. positive result), the regulations for positively tested persons apply, in particular the obligation to reporting to the public health department, 14 days' isolation from the testing date and immediate isolation of the members of your household. More information can be found in the *General decree on the isolation of category I contacts, suspected persons and persons tested positive for coronavirus* in your district or city.
- If the PCR test does not confirm the infection (i.e. negative result), the obligation to isolate yourself is immediately lifted. Also inform your household members.
