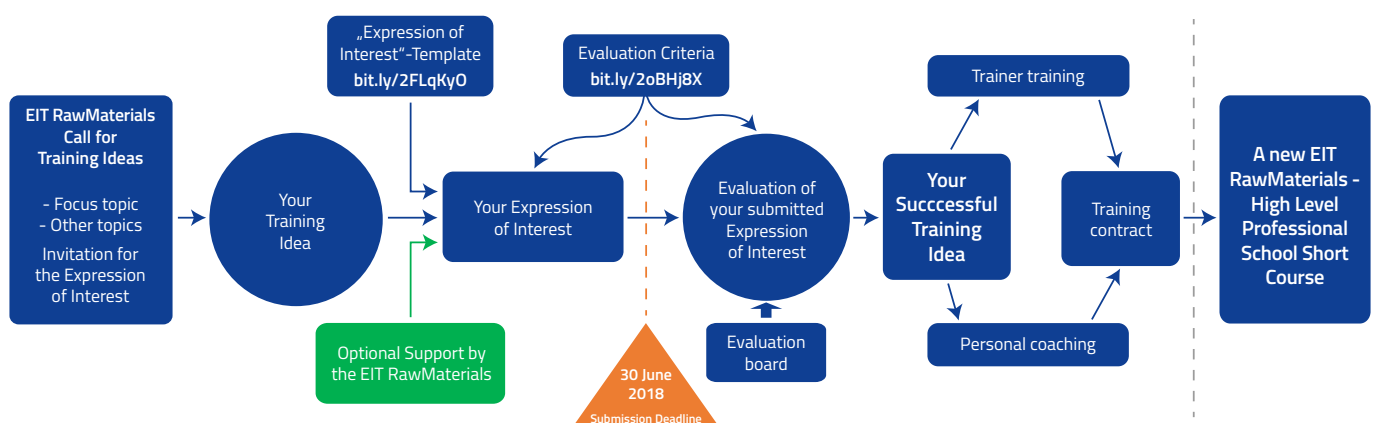
## What are our services?

- The evaluation board evaluates the expressions of interest and delivers a training proposal on the most relevant courses.
- Every submission will receive feedback, so even if your expression of interest did not make the cut at first, you can revise it and resubmit later.
- If your submission has been elected the EIT RawMaterials team will then contact you and will work together with you to launch your idea in the most effective way. Together we will be able to choose which parts of the program for trainer excellence suits you best and you will receive your training contract.
